SCHEDULE I-LM-U IRRIGATION SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

Available to Customers served under Schedule I-LM as of July 31, 2003. Also available to Customers otherwise served under Schedule I-U who agree by contract to remain a bundled service customer of the Cooperative for a minimum twelve month term and to participate in the Cooperative's Load Management Program by allowing the Cooperative to prohibit on-peak usage with a load control switch installed on each pumping load. All service is made available subject to the established Terms and Conditions of the Cooperative.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable for electric service supplied to irrigation pumping loads as an alternative to Schedule I-U not exceeding 50 kW demand where the Cooperative has a load control switch installed on each pumping load to prohibit on-peak usage.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase and multi-phase, 60 hertz at standard available voltages.

MONTHLY RATE

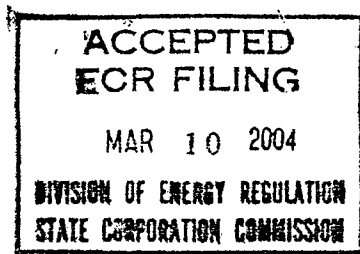

\$0.35 per horsepower per month; plus an additional \$3.25 per horsepower per month during the billing months of June through September, except that this additional charge shall not apply in any month in which 25 kWh or less is consumed.

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PERIODS OF LOAD MANAGEMENT

Periods of load management shall begin when the Cooperative activates the load control switch installed on the Customer's pumping load and shall continue until the load control switch is deactivated by the Cooperative. Notice of the start and finish of Load Management Periods will be by signal provided by operation of the Cooperative's load management system.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be the greater of the following:

1. Customer Delivery Charge plus \$0.35 per horsepower.
2. Such other minimum charge specified in the contract for service as may be established by the special nature of the particular load as provided for in the Cooperative's Terms and Conditions.

Whenever a Customer applies for reconnection of service at the same location within an eighteen-month period of the time the service was disconnected, a charge equal to the sum of the minimum monthly bills determined for the months that the service was disconnected will be billed to the Customer and must be paid by the Customer before reconnection is made.

WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE

The wholesale power cost adjustment clause, as set forth in the Cooperative's Terms and Conditions, shall apply to this Rate Schedule.

DETERMINATION OF HORSEPOWER

The horsepower for billing purposes shall be the motor manufacturer's nameplate rating of horsepower output, except that if the Cooperative so elects, the horsepower shall be determined by actual measurements of power input during a period of maximum normal use, less an allowance of ten percent of input for motor losses.

CONTROL AND METERING EQUIPMENT

The Customer must agree to allow the Cooperative to install all necessary electrical and mechanical equipment used to prohibit or meter on-peak usage.

CONTRACT PERIOD

The contract for service, except for Seasonal and Temporary Service, shall be for an initial term of not less than one (1) year, and shall continue in effect from year to year until terminated.
